2018 Power Upgrade Works Schedule

12 October 2018

Rio Tinto is undertaking significant upgrades to the power network in Nhulunbuy over the coming months to improve the town's industry standard power network.

Nine-day look ahead: Please Note - There are changes to this schedule

Please refer to the Zone Maps (www.goveoperations.com) to see which zone your property is in. A nine day schedule is provided and is updated daily. Please check back daily as adjustments to scheduling based on daily progress by the work crews may occur.

Works conducted on any electricity network is high risk and the safety of our maintenance personnel is our priority. Power may be restored earlier so always treat it as being live.

The works will improve the reliability of power supply by installing isolators throughout the power network. Once installed, the isolators will enable the power network to be divided into zones; ensuring future scheduled maintenance to the power network is able to take place with minimal impact to the town network.

From September 23, what you can expect

- Power outages will be 6-8 hours in duration.
- Your property will be affected multiple times over the duration of the project.

- Works will take place seven days a week.
- Both residential and business properties will be impacted.
- Works will include the use of heavy mobile equipment on streets and driveways.
- Please observe the traffic management in place. Vehicle users and pedestrians are encouraged to take extra precaution during this period.

What we will do to minimise the impact to you

- Where possible, properties will not be affected for more than one consecutive day at a time. Where possible, outages affecting businesses will be minimised.
- For schools and essential service providers, where possible, power interruptions will be scheduled outside of hours.
